

## **CIEH Level 2 Award in Fire Safety Principles**

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### **Introduction:**

The Level 2 Award in Fire Safety Principles allows candidates to develop their basic fire safety awareness. It is particularly useful for employees who are to have a designated responsibility for workplace fire safety, for example as fire wardens or fire marshals, and provides the knowledge that will allow them to carry out duties relating to fire safety and emergency procedures.

### **Course Certification**

Delegates who attend the course and successfully pass the multiple choice answer assessment paper are awarded a certificate by CIEH.

### **Course Description**

This is a one day classroom based course with embedded interactive student activities and culminates in a 30 question multiple choice answer assessment paper. This can be enhanced by an additional practical fire fighting training session if desired – please contact the centre to discuss this option.

### **COURSE REQUIREMENTS**

This course can be taken as an entry level qualification, but does follow on well from the CIEH Level 1 Award in Fire Safety Awareness. It will require good levels of literacy and a commitment to work intensively during the course.
